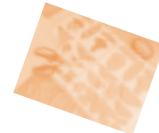

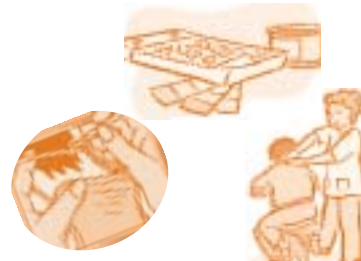

## TEEN/MINOR (MIP) Alcohol Awareness Program

# REGISTRATION INFORMATION

## Registration

Pre-registration is required. You may register for Spring 2005 Community Education classes by any of the five ways we have listed. We accept cash, check, money order, MasterCard and Visa. ## Tuitions and Fees

## Refunds/Cancellations
